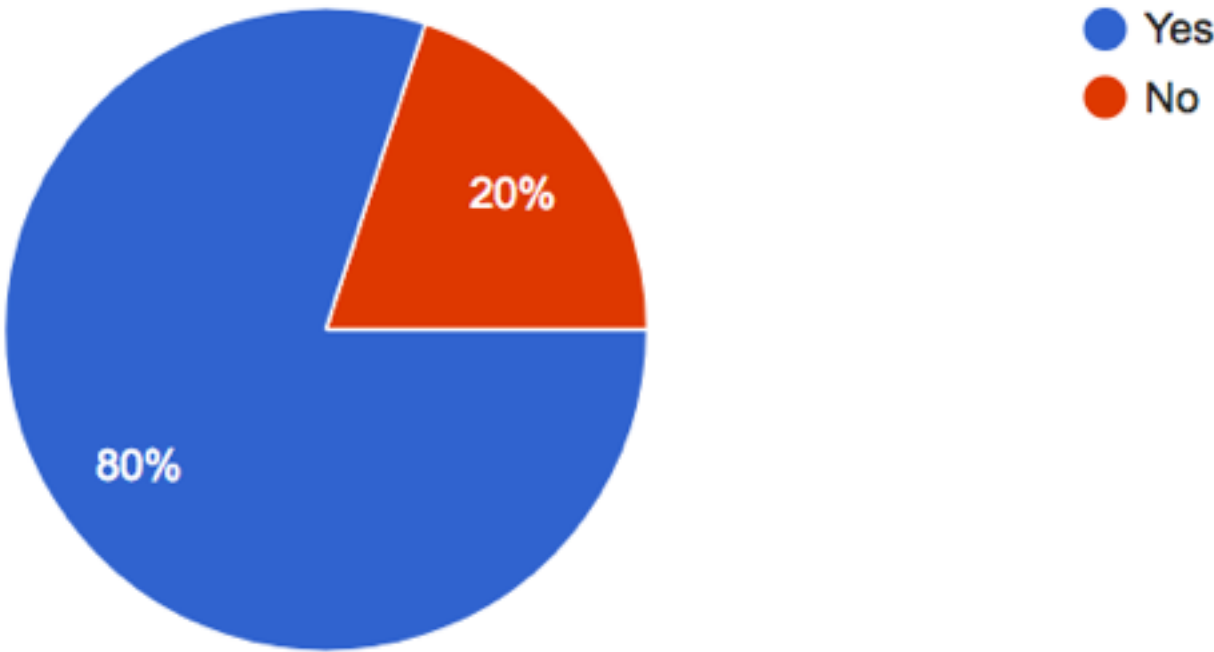

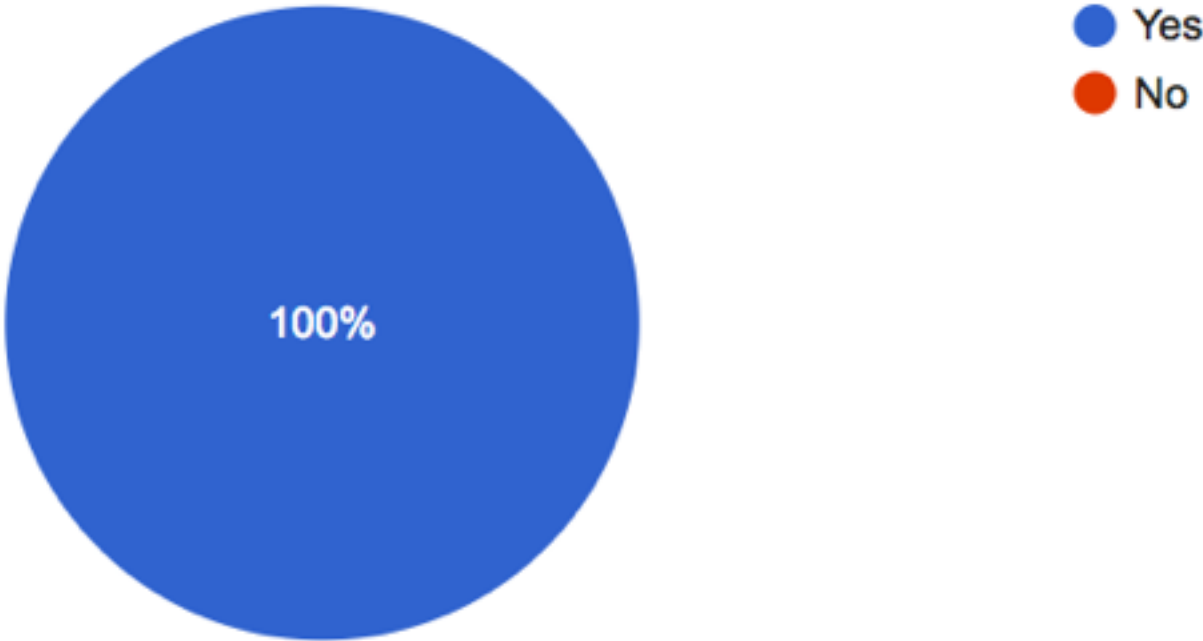

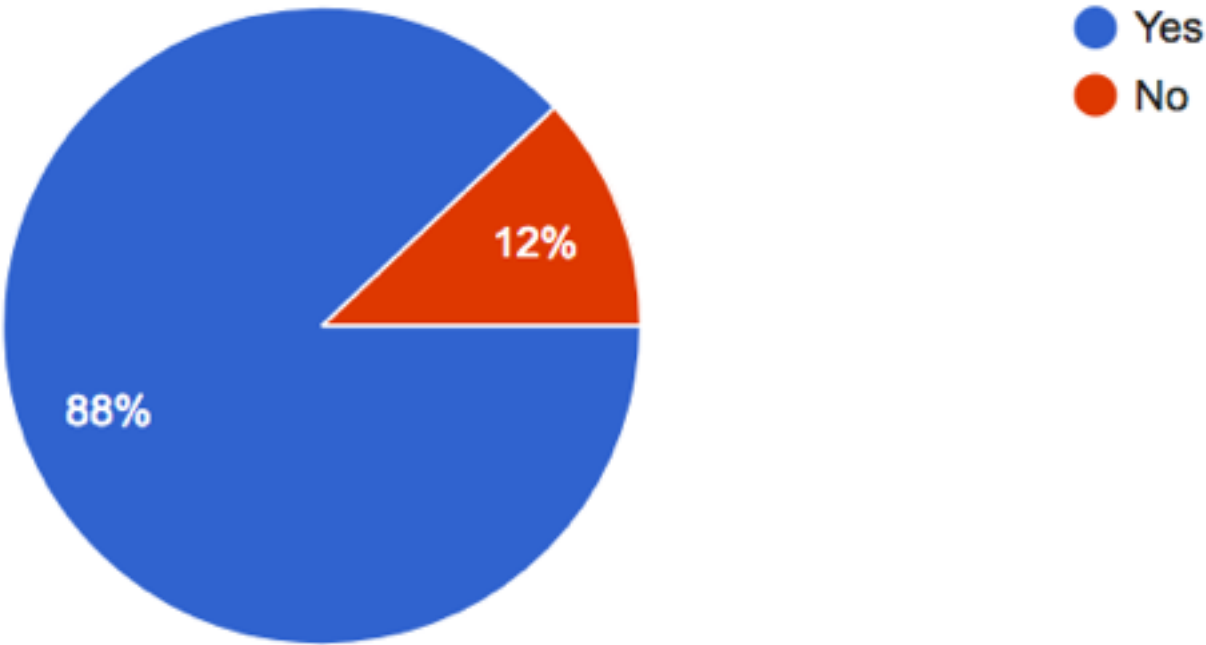

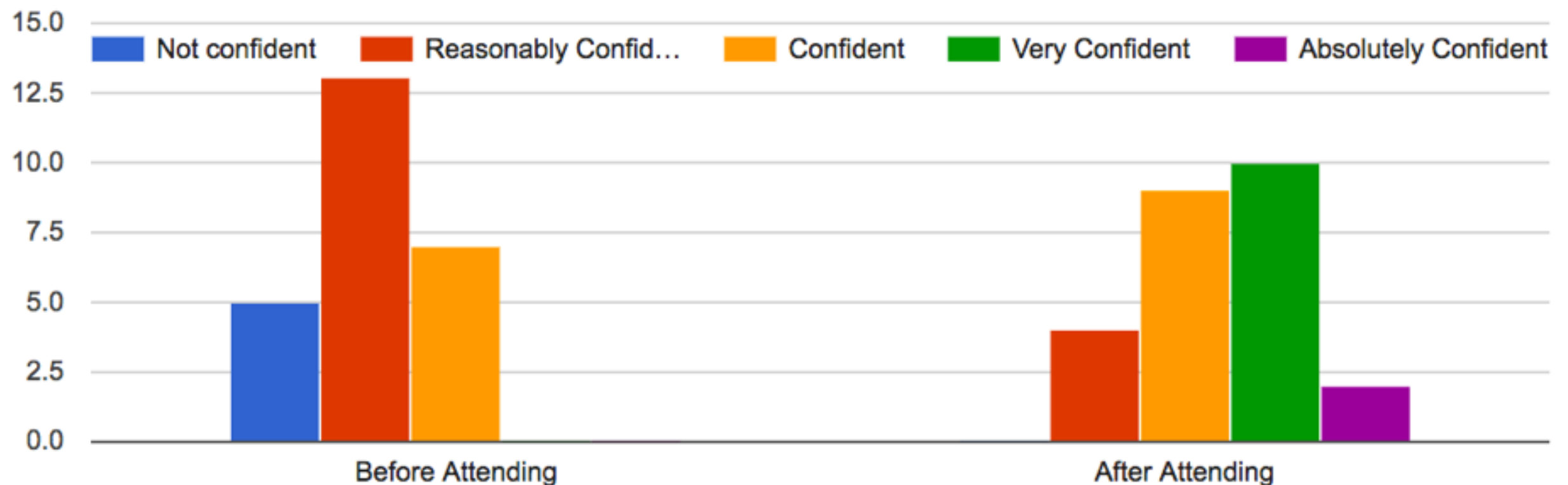
Do you feel Creative Computing Club has helped you with your general level of confidence?

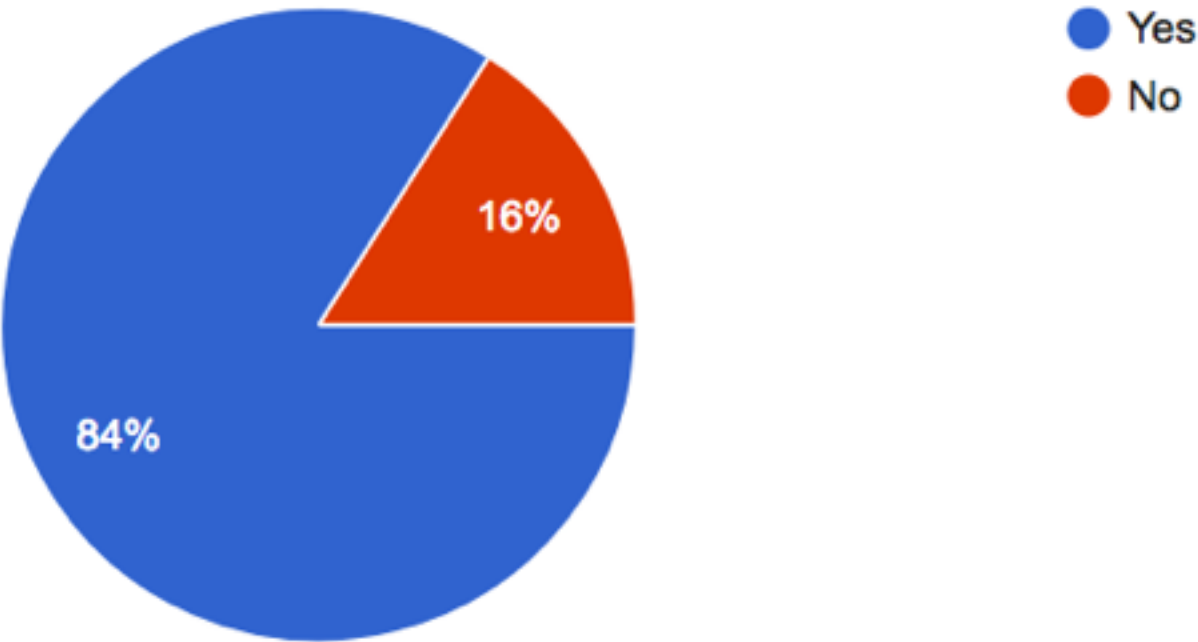
How has your general confidence changed since attending Creative Computing Club?

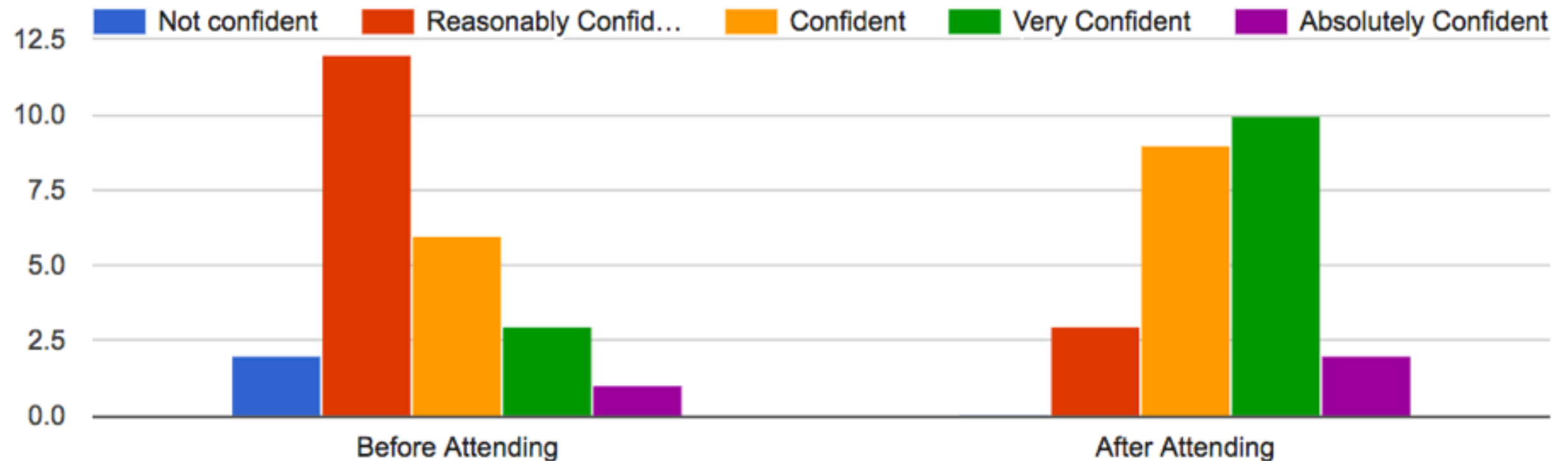
Do you feel Creative Computing Club has helped you with your confidence in learning?

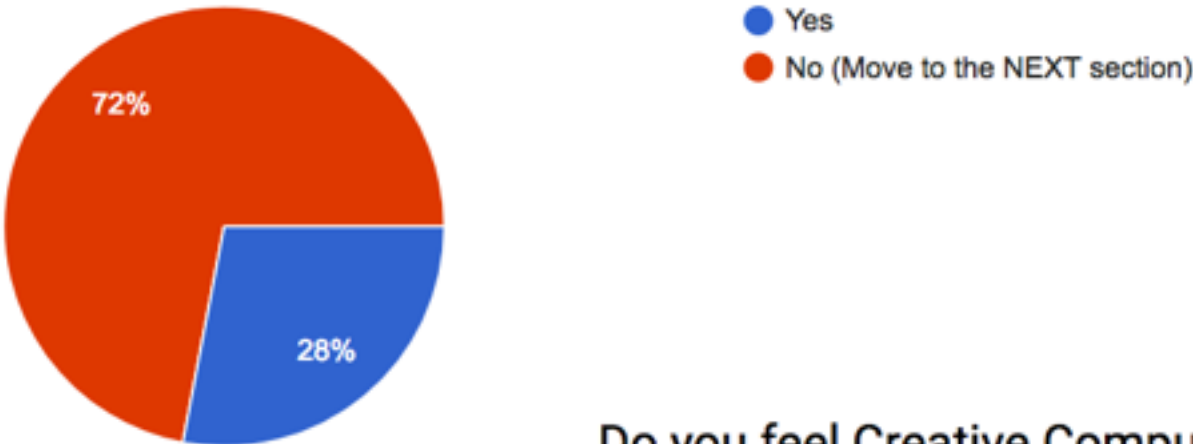
How has your confidence in learning changed since attending Creative Computing Club?

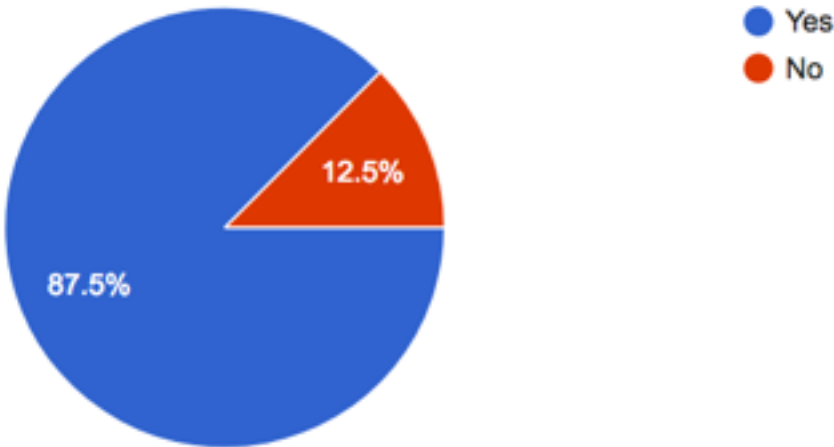
Do you have any Special Education Needs or Disabilities?

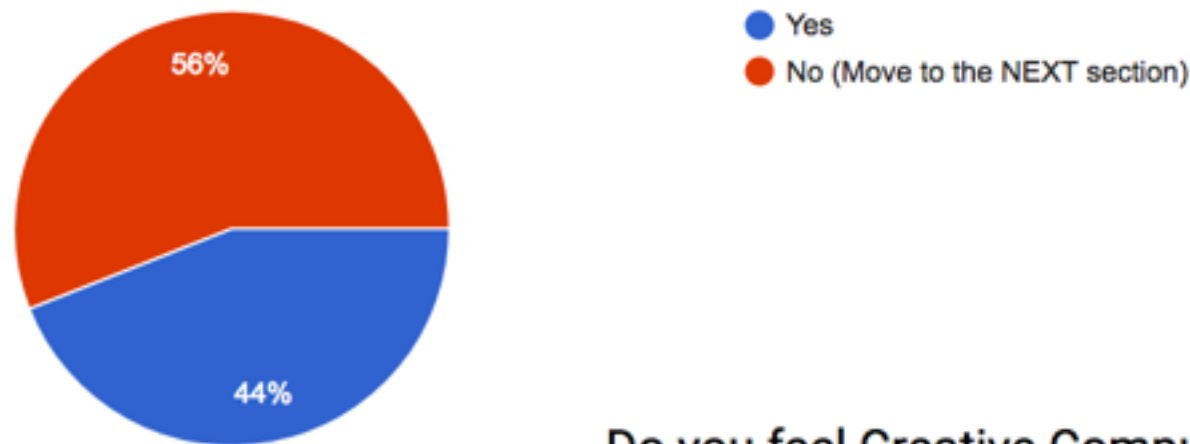

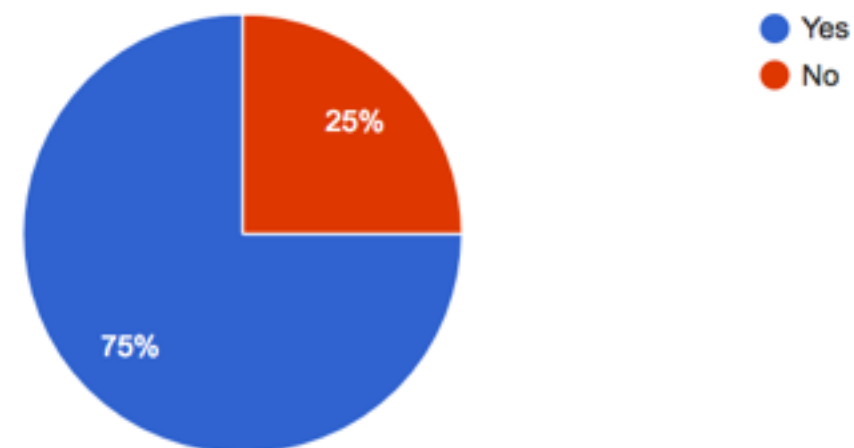

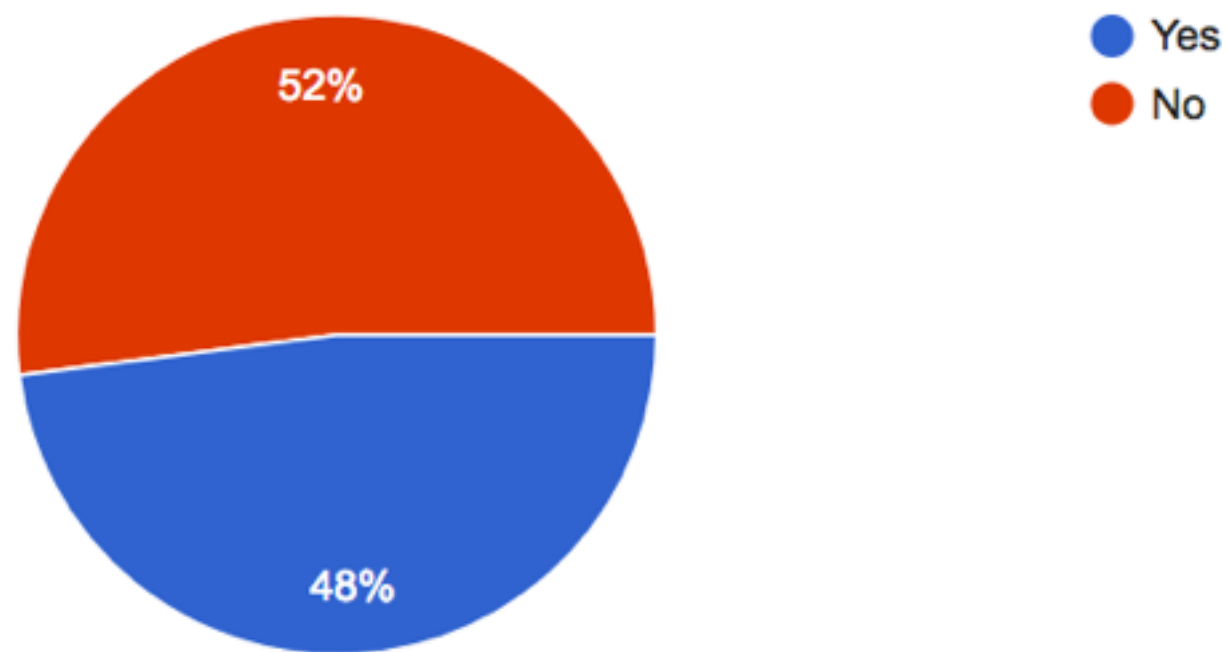

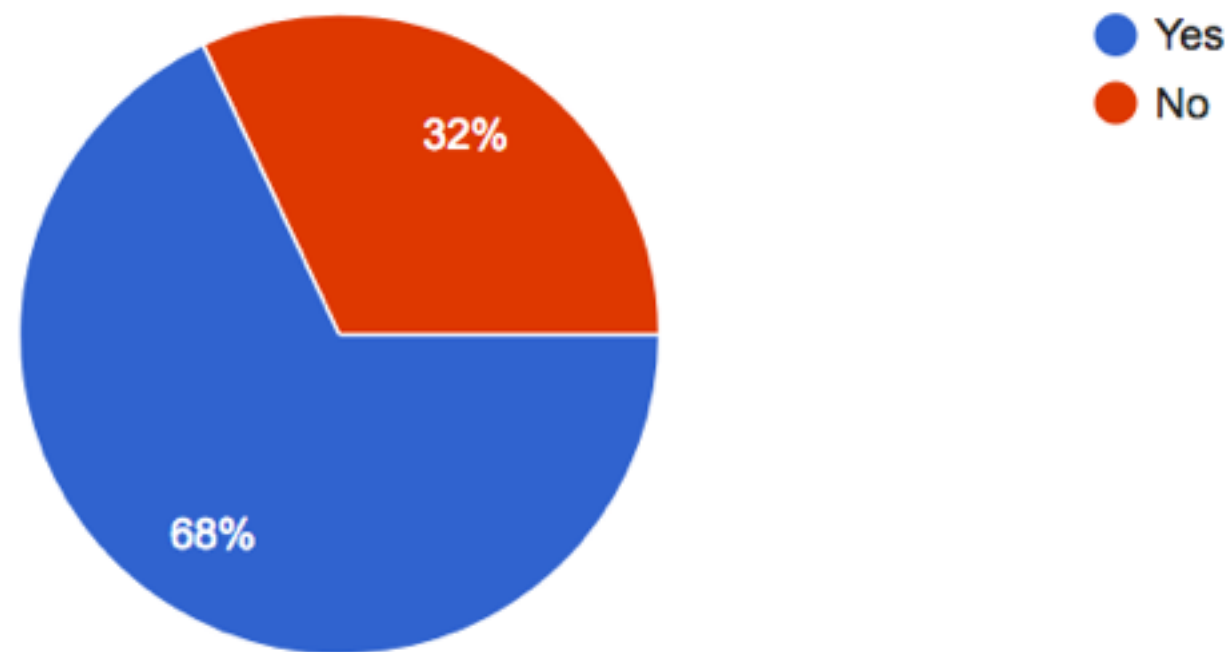

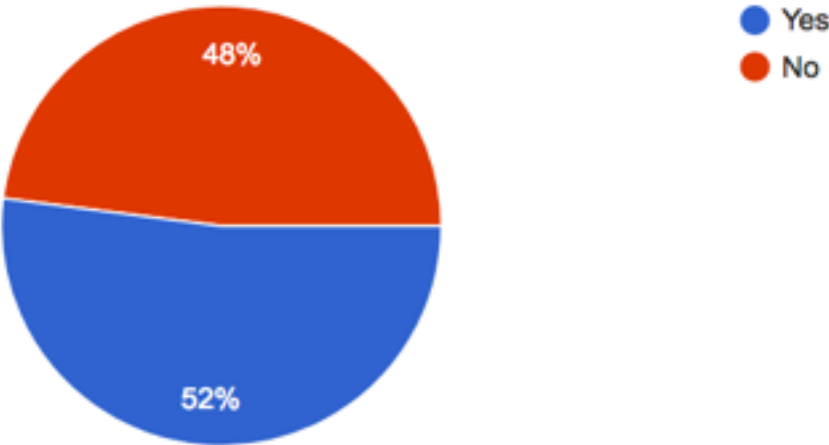

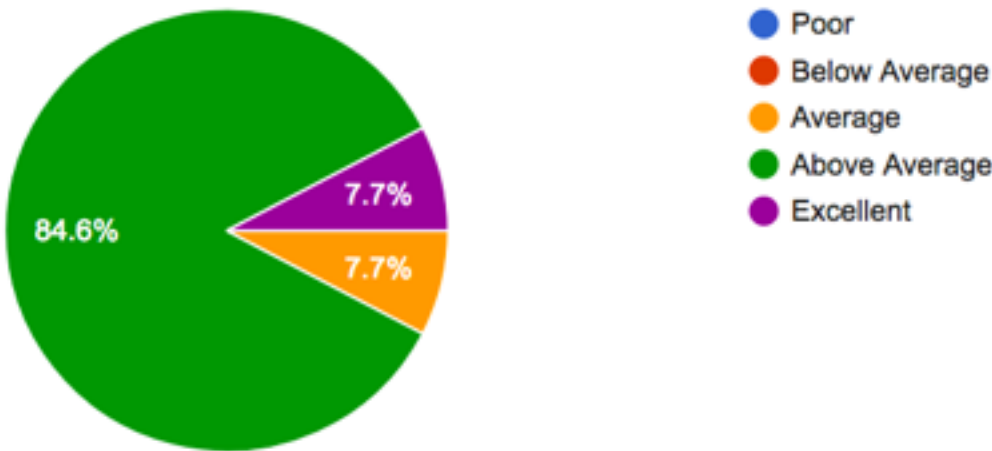
Has the Creative Computing Club offered you any advice on further or higher education?

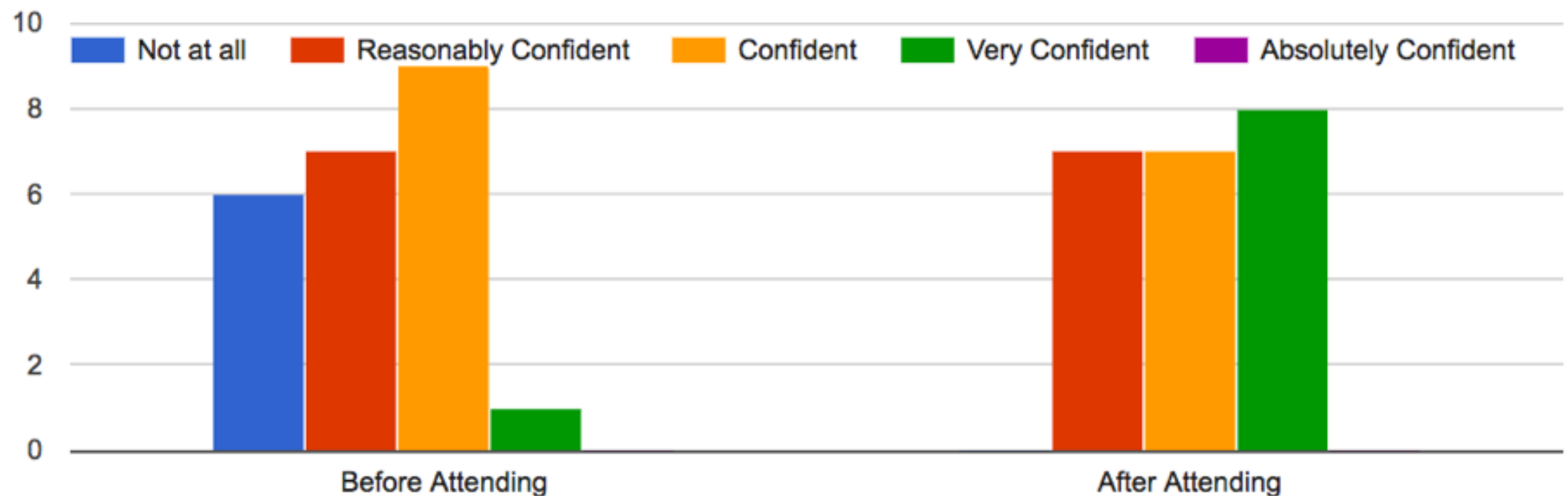

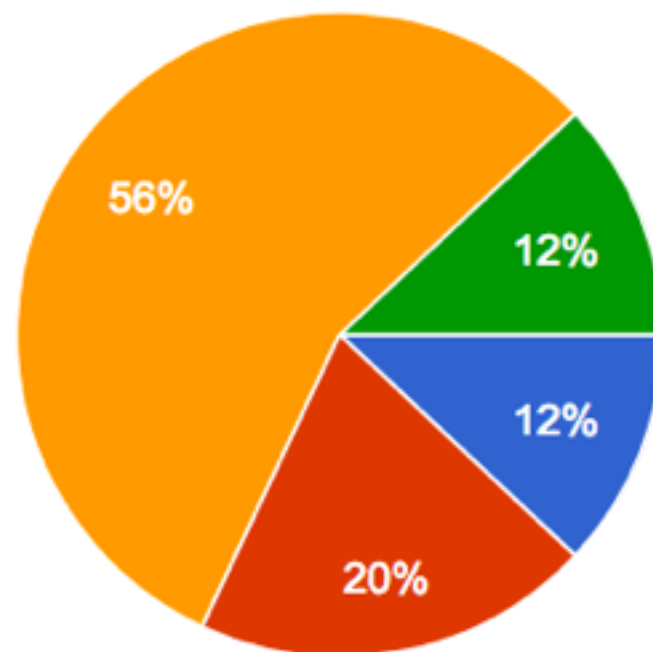
Has your confidence changed with regards to your further and higher education options since attending Creative Computing Club?

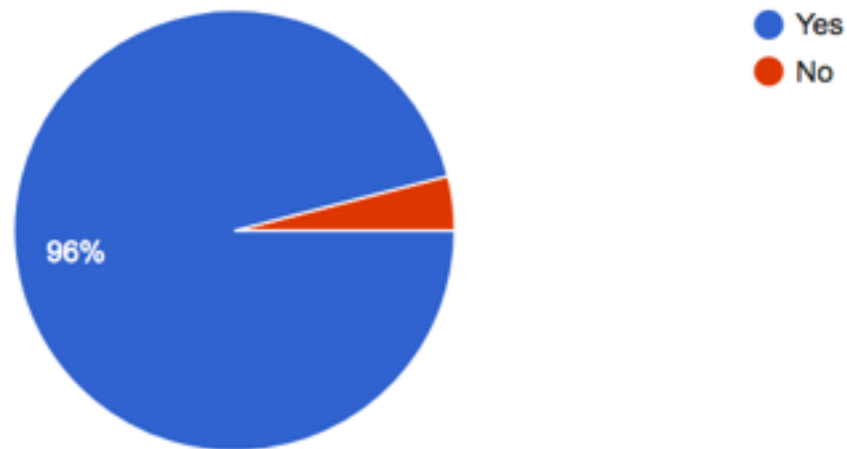

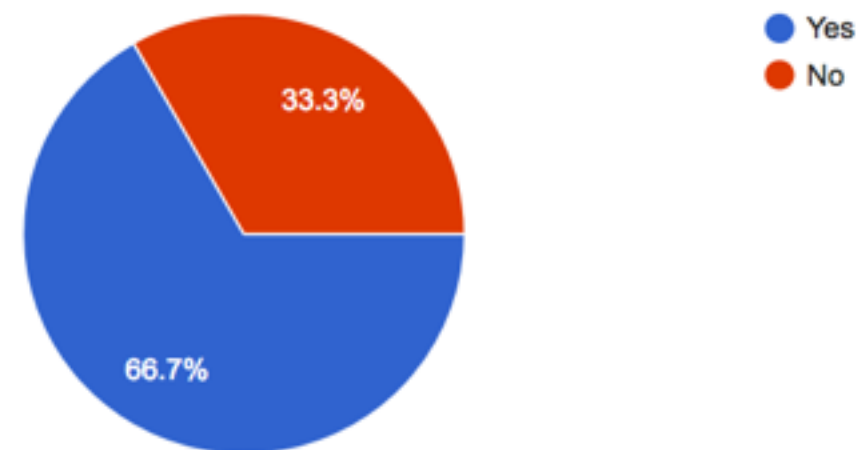
Have you made any new friends at Creative Computing Club friends since you started attending?

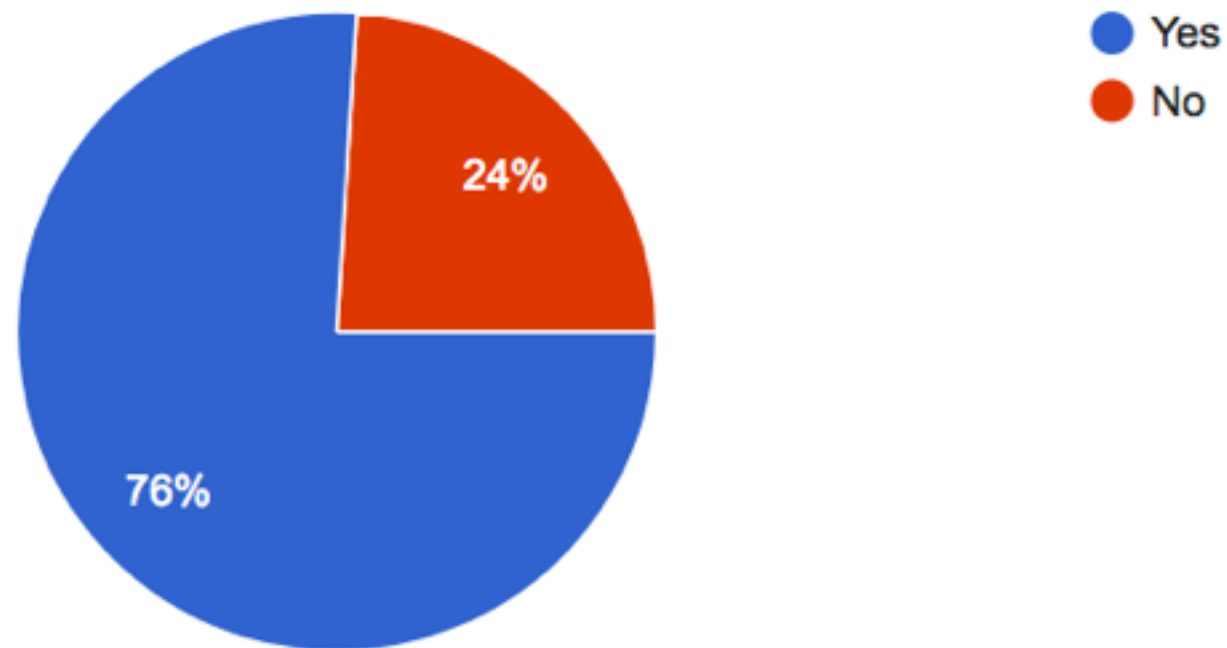

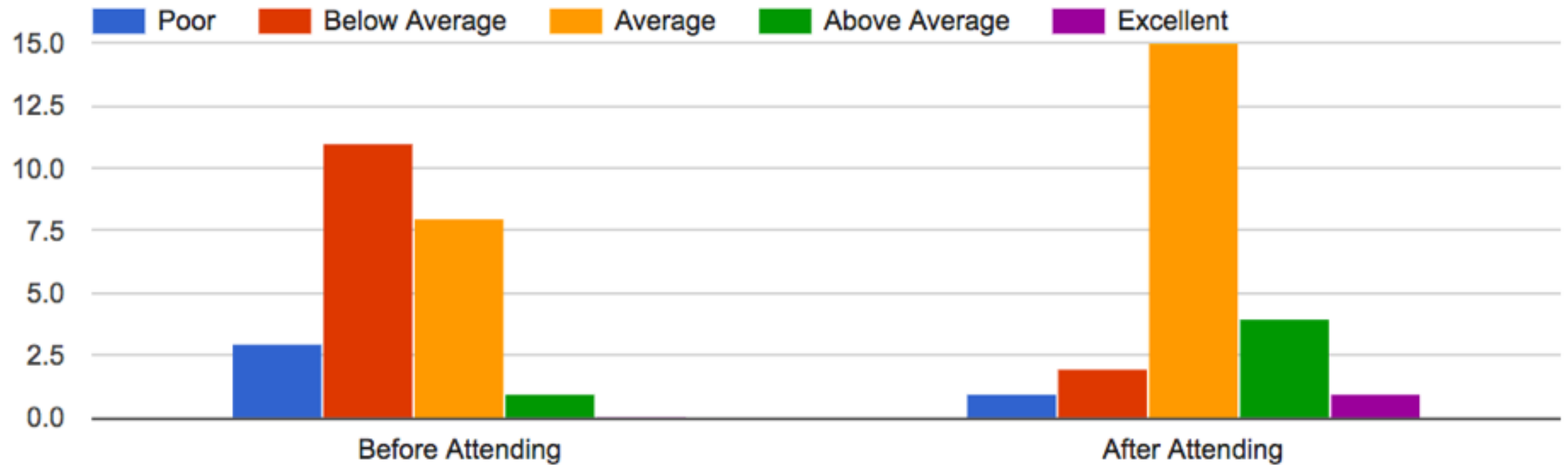
Do you feel attending the Creative Computing Club has helped you with your social skills?

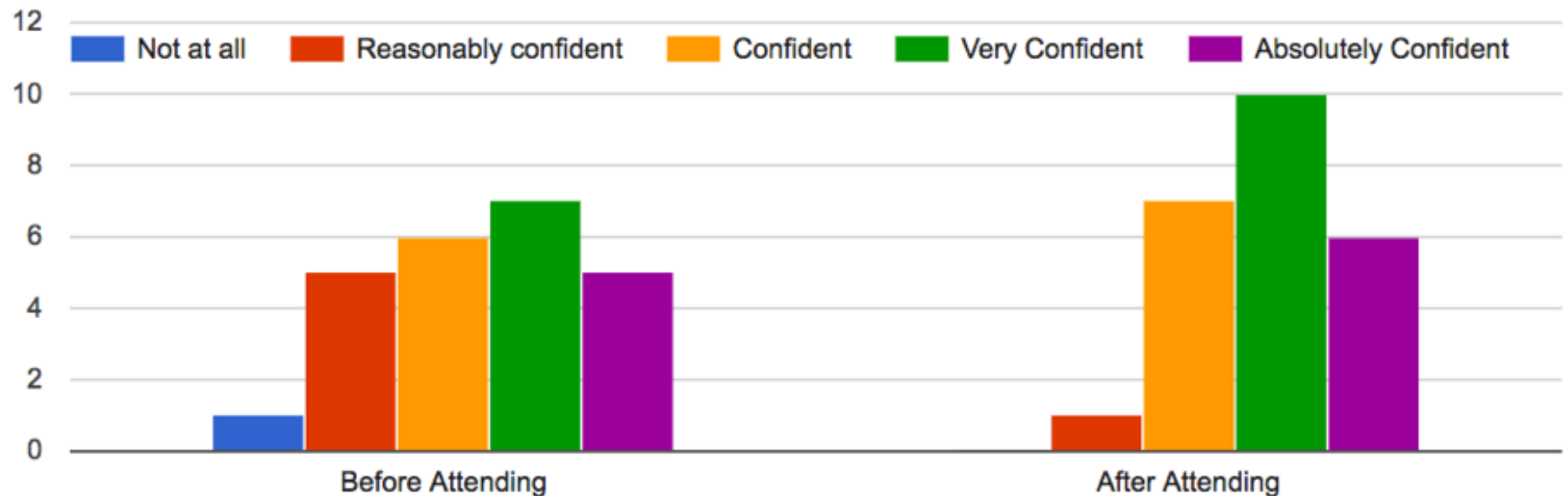

How have your social skills changed since attending Creative Computing Club?



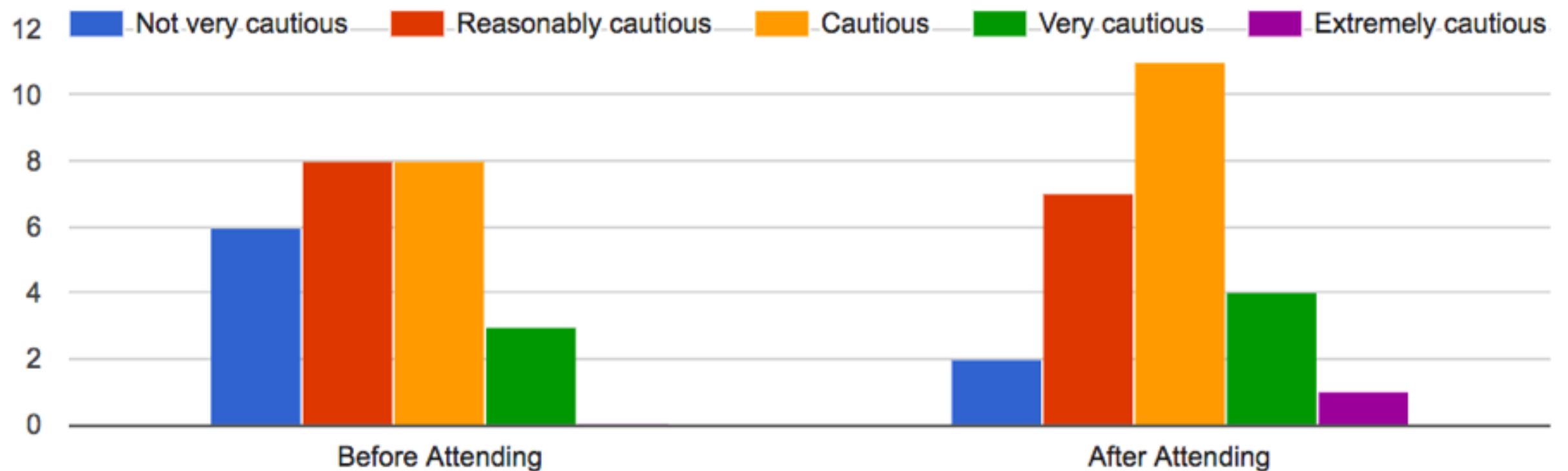

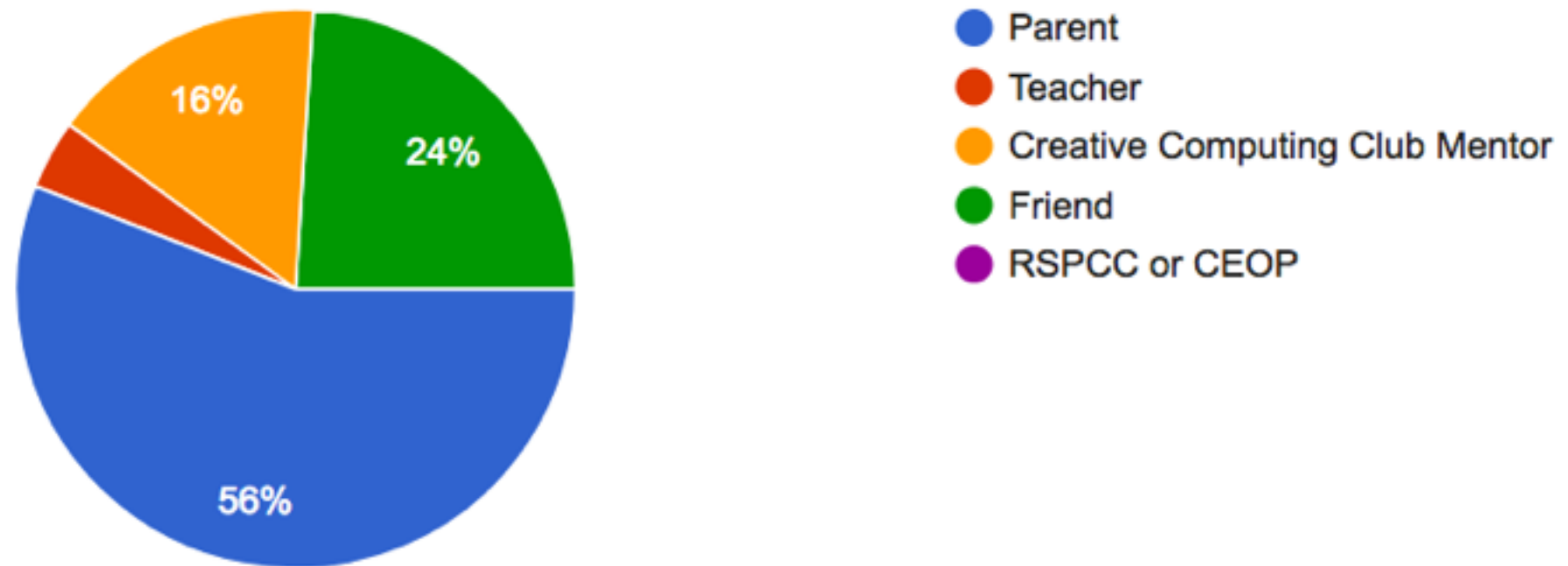
How cautious online are you since you have attended Creative Computing Club?

If you were concerned about something online where would you go for help?

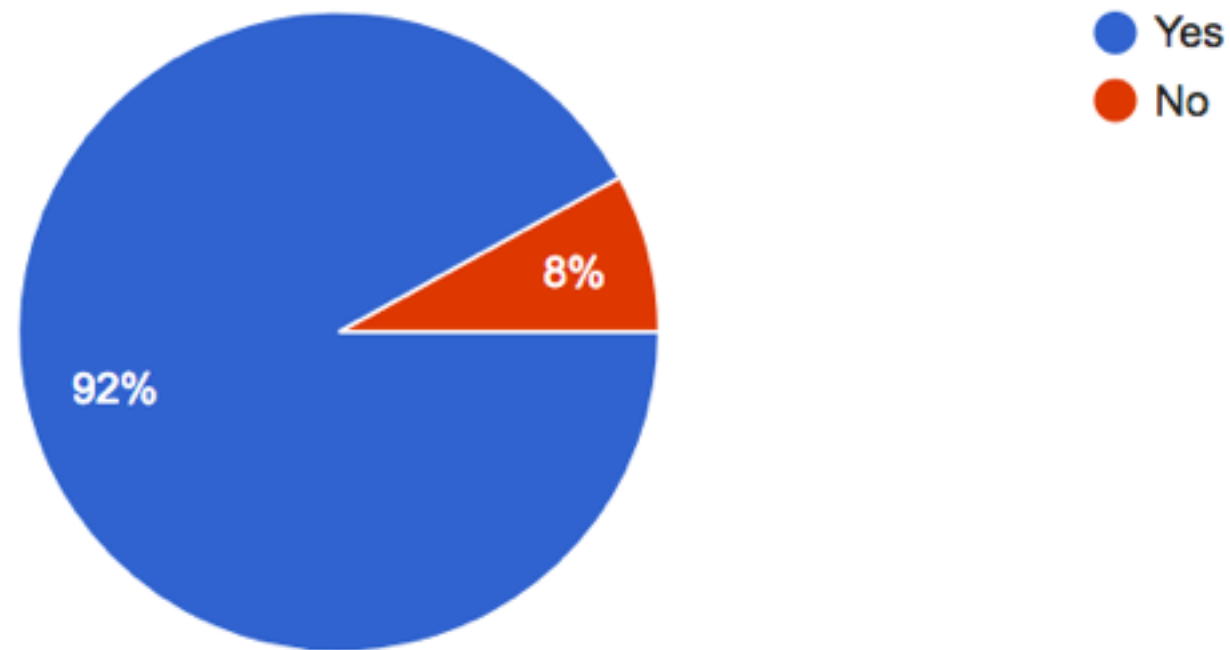

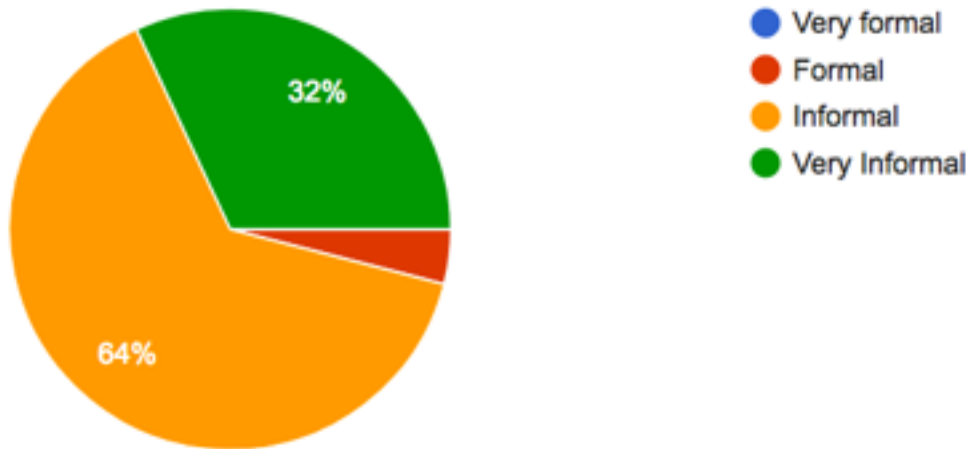

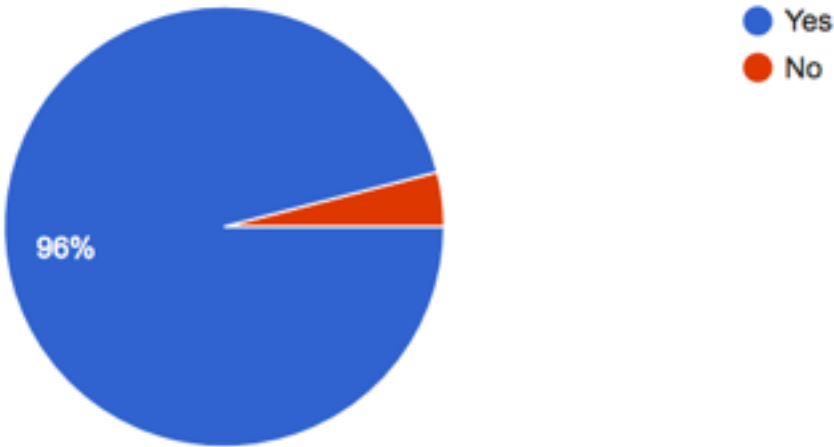
How would you describe the mentors teaching style?

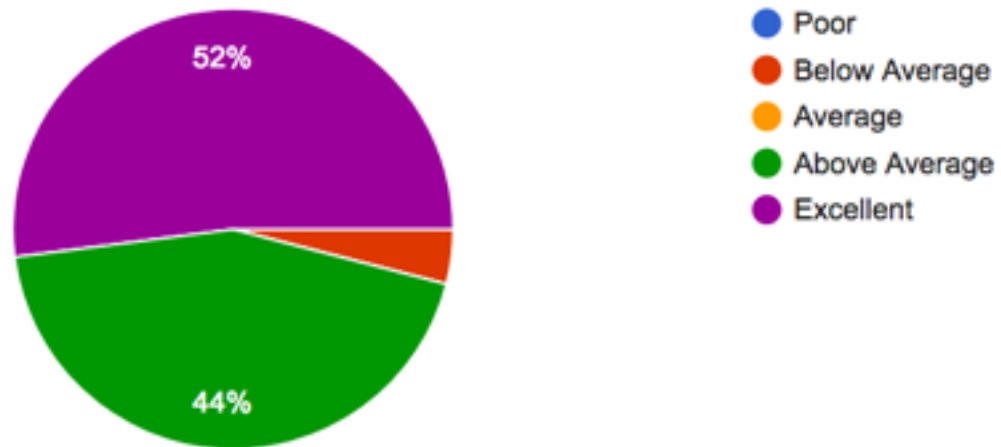

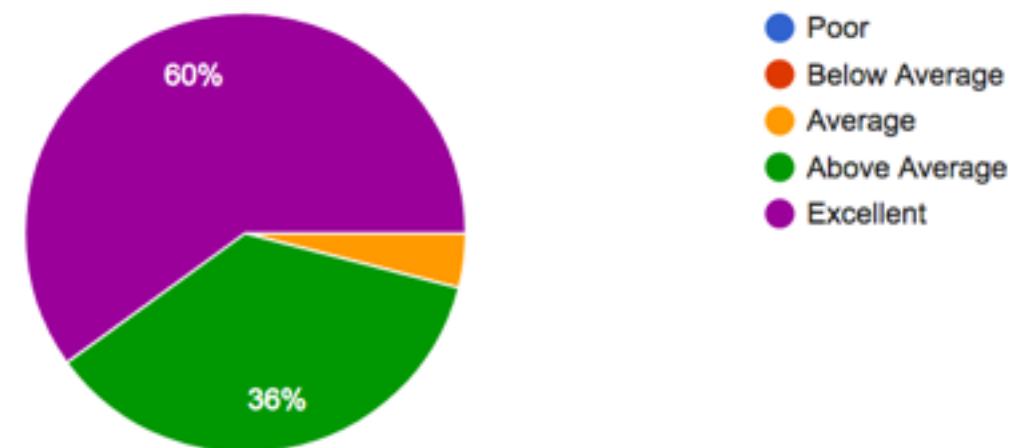
How would describe the the quality of the teaching?

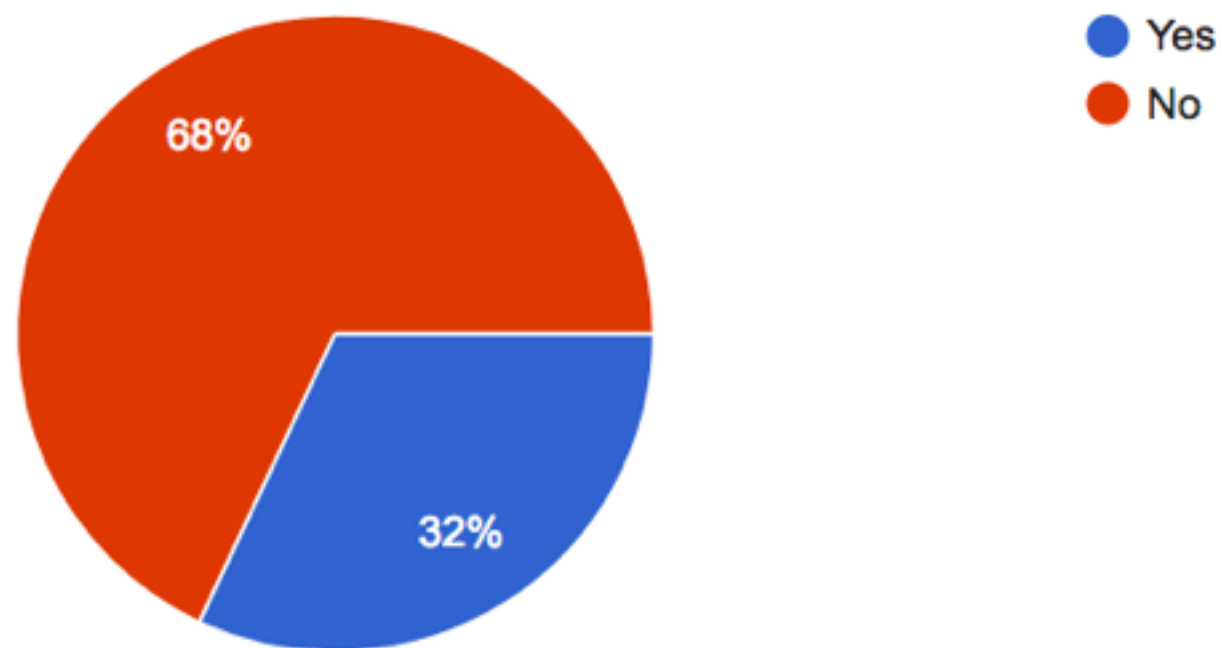

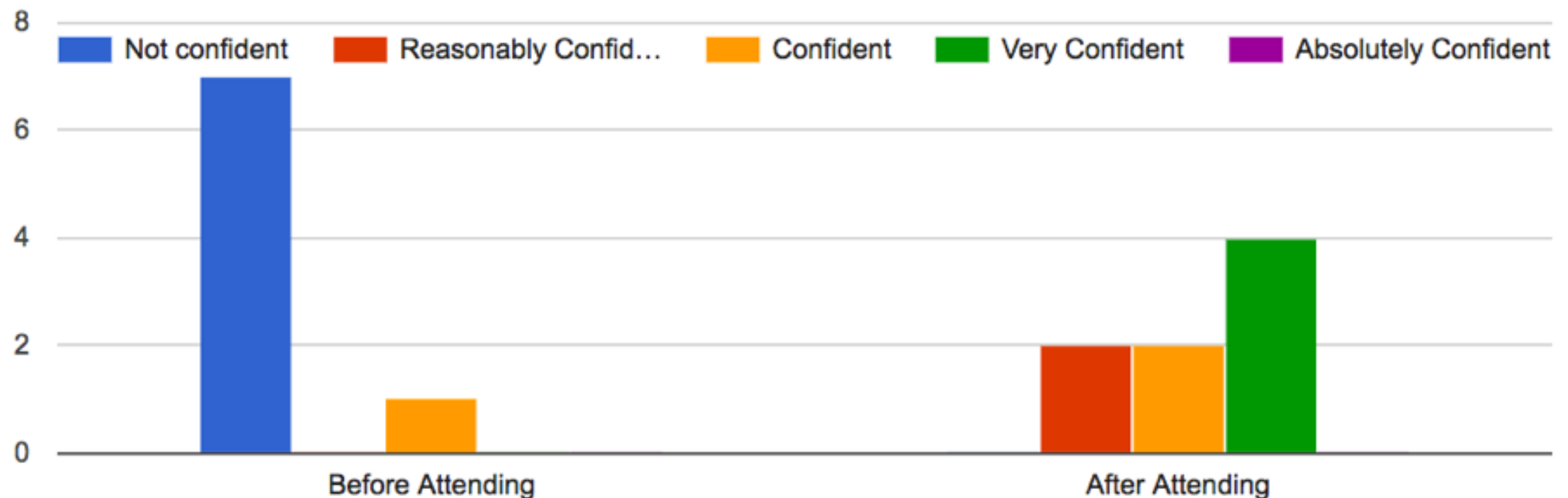
Did you join the Creative Computing Club to learn a "specific skill"?

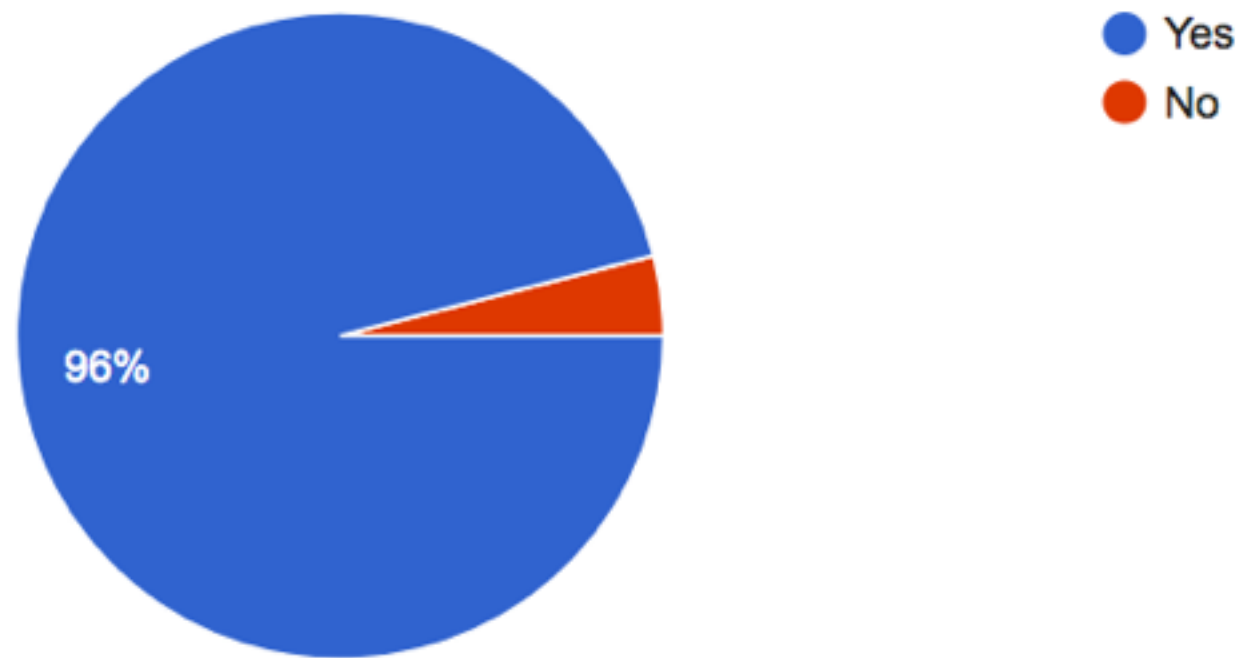
If you answered "Yes" to the "Specific Skill" question. How do you feel about that new skill since attending Creative Computing Club?
